ATTENTION ALL CRUSADER PARENTS AND STUDENTS! OUR DISTANCE
LEARNING SCHEDULE WILL BE CHANGING EFFECTIVE JANUARY 12TH 2021!

We know that supporting your students' learning at home has been challenging, and we appreciate the many ways that you have shown dedication and commitment to ensuring that our students have the best chance at successful outcomes during distance learning. Over the past few months, we have seen our students and staff adapt to new daily routines, new classroom settings, and new ways to deliver instruction. What has not waivered is our commitment at Cole to develop LEADers and ensure that our students engage in meaningful and joyful learning every day. We recognize how critical it is for our students to have a continued positive connection with our school. As we move into the second semester, we are adjusting our current practices to ensure that we are doing what is best for our students, and constantly seeking ways to positively impact their learning. We noticed specific challenges with regards to asynchronous (independent) work during the first semester and have concerns about poor student engagement. At the start of second semester, January 12th, 2021, we will be moving forward with a change in our Distance Learning schedule. This change reflects input from students, parents,

teachers, support staff, and administrators regarding the overall effectiveness of our current schedule. The new distance learning schedule was shared and approved at the EUSD Board meeting on December 2nd, 2020. The change will ensure that students receive more direct instruction, timely support, and feedback during what was designated as asynchronous, independent practice time within our first semester schedule. Our current data indicates a higher number of students in danger of failing due to lack of participation in completing asynchronous work. With the new schedule, students will have increased synchronous (live virtual) interaction with their teachers in all their classes which will minimize the required time for asynchronous (independent) work. In addition, our teachers will continue to support students during optional tutoring and enrichment opportunities available from 3-4 pm daily. Attached to this Newsletter, you will find a copy of our new schedule for ALL (Group A, B, and C) students.

Our administrative and teaching staff are consistently looking at ways to improve learning for all students. We are hopeful that this schedule will provide our students with the academic and social/emotional support they need during these challenging times. Please remember that we are here to assist with distance learning challenges and still have many services in place, including student meals, counseling services, academic support, and connections with outside agencies. We are just a phone call or email away, so please do not hesitate to reach out to us. We want to thank you for your understanding and continued dedication to learning. Please remind your students that we are proud of them as well. Continue to be safe, healthy, and hopeful. Go Crusaders!

Aeries Portal/Grade Checks:

Students should now be able to access their grades on Aeries Student Portal. Please let us know if your student can't access their grades. Students will need to upload or email their signed grade checks to their advisory teachers on a weekly basis. Parents can also create their own Aeries Portal account where they can see their students grades, assignments and absences. Follow the link below to create a Parent Portal account.

The following are instructions for conducting grade checks:

1. Students will open up Aeries Student Portal. (Same link for parent portal)

https://eastsideusd.aeries.net/student/LoginParent.aspx

- 2. Turn to page 119 in their planners. This is the grade check page.
- 3. Record their grade percentages on the grade check page for the current week. (95%, 76%, 67%, ETC...)
- 4. Have their parent/guardian sign the signature line.
- 5. Take a picture of the signed grade check sheet.
- 6. Email grade check picture to their advisory teacher or upload as an assignment in Google Classroom.

Students with 2 or more F's will be placed on academic probation and will be required to serve 1 hour of mandatory tutoring each week on Wednesday afternoons or during Saturday school until their grades improve. Students that do not submit grade checks will also be placed on academic probation. This process will take place weekly.

Message from the Cafeteria:

We want to share some important information with you since there have been recent changes to our meal service program. The USDA approved our district to serve all children ages 18 and under. This means that we can now provide meals to all children, not just students of Eastside Union School District. For meal pick ups, parents can choose from these two options but not both:

- 1. You can either pick up a weekly bulk meal kit on Wednesdays at one of our school campuses (expect Eastside and Enterprise Elementary) from 7:30-10:30 a.m. or from 3:00-5:00 p.m. This meal kit will contain food for seven days.
- 2. Or you can pick up a hot meal Monday through Thursday from any of our bus stops. Friday's meals are given on Thursdays.


