Notice is hereby given that the governing board ("Board") of

will receive sealed bids for the following project:

1. Eastside Union School District is seeking qualified contractors to submit bids for the installation of (7) shade structures at (3) of our elementary schools. The scope work includes but is not limited to installation of durable and safe shade structures in designated areas on school grounds. We are also seeking installation of water filling stations at designated school sites.

Scope of Work

- Enterprise Elementary School Shade Structure and Playgrounds
- Scope of work includes, but is not limited to a) the demolition of (2) existing drinking fountains, the demolition of (3) 38'x16' existing shade structures, and the demolition of (1) 30'x40' existing shade structure; b) the installation of (2) 40'x44' new metal shade structures and associated flatwork; c) the installation of (1) 40'x64' new metal shade structure and associated flatwork; d) the installation of (4) new accessible bottle filling stations with associated framing; e) the installation of (2) new 24'x50' artificial turf areas; and f) the installation of new parking signages at exiting ADA stalls in existing parking lots. Work includes new underground utilities with sawcut, trenching, backfill with asphalt and concrete patch back, as well as new electrical conduit pathway and wiring through existing buildings (walls, ceilings, patching, painting, etc.) to existing panels for new power, lighting, and associated controls. - Scope of work includes, but is not limited to a) the demolition of (6) existing drinking fountains; b) the installation of (1) 40'x44' new metal shade structures and associated flatwork; c) the installation of (1) 30'x36' new metal shade structure and associated flatwork; d) the installation of (1) 40'x64' new metal shade structure and associated flatwork; e) the installation of (4) new accessible bottle filling stations with associated framing; f) the installation of (1) new 40'x44' rubberized surface area; and g) the installation of new parking signages at exiting ADA stalls in the existing parking lot. Work includes new underground utilities with sawcut, trenching, backfill with asphalt and concrete patch back, as well as new electrical conduit pathway and wiring through existing buildings (walls, ceilings, patching, painting, etc.) to existing panels for new power, lighting, and associated controls. - All work needs to be completed by September 9, 2025
- Include a 15% contingency in your quote to account for potential unforeseen
- circumstances or additional expenses. Ensure that the total, including the contingency, is clearly stated in your submission.
- 2. To bid on this Project, the Bidder is required to possess the following State of California Contractor License:

#### B, C10, C36 and other applicable licenses

The Bidder's license(s) must remain active and in good standing throughout the term of the Contract.

- 4. All bids shall be on the form provided by the District. Each bid must conform and be responsive to all pertinent Contract Documents, including, but not limited to, the Instructions to Bidders.

5. All Bids must be sealed in an envelope and marked on the outside of the envelope containing the following:

Failure to include sufficient information to identify the Bidder, by including the Bidder's name or address, may result in the rejection of the Bid. Each Bid must receive a time stamp provided by the District indicating the time the Bid was received by the District. The time stamp will be placed on the Bid by a District employee when the Bid is received at the front lobby of the District and in compliance with the requirements set forth below in paragraph 6.

6. Sealed Bids will be received until:

Any bid that is submitted after 2:00PM. as determined by the official bid clock in the lobby of the District Office, shall be non-responsive and returned to the bidder. Bids received via Federal Express, United Parcel Service (UPS), or United States Postal Service delivery must be *received* by the district no later than 2:00p.m. PDT, March 27, **2025**, as determined by the district's official bid clock located in the lobby of the District Office and as indicated by the time stamp placed on the Bid by a District employee when the Bid is received. Any bid received via Federal Express, United Parcel Service (UPS), or United States Postal Service delivery after 2:00p.m. PDT, shall be non-responsive and returned to the bidder. Failure to timely deliver a bid that is attributable to the carrier shall not constitute an excuse for untimely delivery. Bids transmitted via Federal Express, United Parcel Service (UPS), or United States Postal Service delivery must be placed in a separately sealed envelope inside of the Federal Express, United Parcel Service (UPS), or United States Postal Service package. Failure to include all required documents may render the bid non- responsive. Those bids timely received, shall be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:05 p.m. on March 27<sup>th</sup> at the District Office. Any claim by a bidder of error in its bid must be made in compliance with

section 5100 et seq. of the Public Contract Code.

7. A bid bond by an admitted surety insurer on the form provided by the District, cash, or a cashier's check or a certified check, drawn to the order of the Eastside Union School District, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total bid price, shall accompany the Bid Form and Proposal, as a guarantee that the Bidder will, within seven (7) calendar days after the date of the Notice of Award, enter into a contract with the District for the performance of the services as stipulated in the bid.

There will be a pre-bid conference and site visit on <u>March 14, 2025, at 9 A.M.</u> sharp for the purpose of acquainting all prospective bidders with the bid documents and the work site. Prospective bidders are to meet in front of the Eastside Elementary School site 6742 E Ave H, Lancaster, CA 93535.

- 8. All attendees must sign-in when arriving at the location. The District reserves the right to conduct an additional pre-bid conference if deemed necessary.
- 9. The successful Bidder shall be required to furnish a 100% Performance Bond and a 100% Payment Bond if it is awarded the contract for the Work.
- 10. The successful Bidder may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the District to ensure performance under the Contract, in accordance with the provisions of section 22300 of the Public Contract Code.
- Where applicable, bidders must meet the requirements set forth in Public Contract Code section 10115 et seq., Military and Veterans Code section 999 et seq. and California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Section 1896.60 et seq. regarding Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise ("DVBE") Programs. Forms are included in the Bid documents (N/A).
- 12. The Contractor and all Subcontractors under the Contractor shall pay all workers on all work performed pursuant to this Contract not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work as determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, State of California, for the type of work performed and the locality in which the work is to be performed within the boundaries of the District, pursuant to sections 1770 et seq. of the California Labor Code. Prevailing wage rates are available from the Department of Industrial Relations and on the Internet at:

13. Pursuant to Labor Code sections 1725.5 and 1771.1, all contractors and subcontractors

that wish to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, or enter a contract to perform public work must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations. No bid will be accepted, nor any contract entered without proof of the contractor's and subcontractors' current registration with the Department of Industrial Relations to perform public work. If awarded a Contract, the Bidder and its subcontractors, of any tier, shall maintain active registration with the Department of Industrial Relations for the duration of the Project.

- 14. This Project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations. In bidding on this project, it shall be the Bidder's sole responsibility to evaluate and include the cost of complying with all labor compliance requirements under this contract and applicable law in its bid.
- 15. The District shall award the Contract, if it awards it at all, to the lowest responsive responsible bidder based on the base bid amount only.
- 16. The Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids and/or waive any irregularity in any bid received. If the District awards the Contract, the security of unsuccessful bidder(s) shall be returned within sixty (60) calendar days from the time the award is made. Unless otherwise required by law, no bidder may withdraw its bid for ninety (90) days after the date of the bid opening.
